The LeagueSafe course is an online safety awareness course, designed to create a safe, healthy and fun Rugby League environment and outlines the role of the **LeagueSafe Trainer** on game day.



Who should do this Course?

This course is for anyone who would like to act in the role of a **LeagueSafe Trainer** during a game of Rugby League.

What's involved in the course?

You will complete an online training course which provides information on the roles and responsibilities of the **LeagueSafe Trainer** during a Rugby League game.

How do I complete the course?

You can register for the course through **<https://learn.playnrl.com>** and is completed once you've finished the online learning and passed all the required assessments.

What do I get?

A LeagueSafe Accreditation.



League First Aid Course

The League First Aid course is the minimum requirement to act in the role of a **First Responder** on game day for U6 to U15's. This course is for anyone who would like to be able to assess and manage injuries during an U6 to U15 Rugby League game.



What's involved in the course?

The course involves self-directed eLearning and 7 hours face to face learning. The online learning must be completed prior to attending the face to face learning.

How do I complete the course?

You can register for the course through <https://learn.playnrl.com> and is completed once you have finished the online and face to face components and passed all the required assessments.

What do I get?

League First Aid Accreditation which lasts for 3 years.

You will also receive:

- HLTAID003 Provide First Aid
- HLTAID001 Provide CPR

Did you know?

If you already have a current HLTAID003 Provide First Aid certificate you can apply for recognition of prior learning. You will only need to complete 3 hours Face to Face at a cost of \$30.

Level 1 Sports Trainer Course

The Level 1 Sports Trainer course will allow you to act in the role of a **First Responder** for any age group but is the minimum requirement to act in the role of a **First Responder** on game day for U16's and above. This course is for anyone who would like to be able to assess and manage injuries at any community Rugby League game.



What's involved in the course?

The course involves self-directed eLearning and 12 hours face to face learning. The online learning must be completed prior to attending the face to face learning.

What do I get?

Level 1 Sports Trainer Accreditation which lasts for 3 years.

You will also receive:

- HLTAID003 Provide First Aid
- HLTAID001 Provide CPR

How do I complete the course?

You can register for the course through <https://learn.playnrl.com> and is completed once you have finished the online and face to face components and passed all the required assessments.

Did you know?

If you already have a current HLTAID003 Provide First Aid certificate you can apply for recognition of prior learning. You will only need to complete 8 hours Face to Face at a cost of \$90.

Level 2 Sports Trainer Course

The Level 2 Sports Trainer course will allow you to act in the role of **First Responder** for any age group and is ideal for experienced Level 1 Sports Trainers to further develop their skills and knowledge to improve their ability to contribute to a safer Rugby League environment.



Who should do this Course?

The Level 2 Sports Trainer course is designed for anyone who wants to further their Sports Trainer education in order to deal with higher level injuries and can be used at all levels of the game.

What's involved in the course?

This course involves self-directed eLearning and 16 hours face to face learning. The online learning must be completed prior to attending the face to face learning.

How do I complete the course?

You can register for the course through <https://learn.playnrl.com> and is completed once you have finished the online and face to face components and passed all the required assessments.

What do I get?

Level 2 Sports Trainer Accreditation which lasts for 3 years.

You will also receive:

- PUAEME004A Provide Care for Suspected Spinal Injury

To be eligible to complete this course you will need to have a current Level 1 Sports Trainer certificate with 50 hours experience and a current Provide First Aid Statement of Attainment.

Sports Trainer Reaccreditation

This Sports Trainer reaccreditation courses are designed as an easy and effective way of maintaining your Sports Trainer accreditations. This course is for anyone who has a current Sports Trainer accreditation which will expire in less than 6 months. A grace period of 12 months will be granted to anyone whose accreditation has been expired for less than 12 months.



What's involved in the course?

This course can be completed either face to face or online.

What do I get?

Level 1 or 2 Sports Trainer Reaccreditation which lasts for 3 years.

CPR

This is a nationally recognised qualification which teaches the participant how to effectively apply CPR. In accordance with the Australian Resuscitation Council guidelines this course needs to be completed annually.

This course involves self-directed eLearning and 1.5 hours face to face learning. The online learning must be completed prior to attending the face to face learning.

HLTAID001 Provide CPR Accreditation which lasts for 12 months.
